## Special Olympics Great Britain Table Tennis Development Plan 2025 - 2027



#### Introduction

This Table Tennis Development Plan (2025 - 2027) sets out a clear framework for the structured growth of the sport within SOGB. It focuses on expanding inclusive and accessible participation opportunities, strengthening athlete pathways from local to international levels, and deepening collaboration with National Governing Bodies to enhance opportunities for people with Intellectual and Learning disabilities (ID and LD) across GB. The plan outlines our priorities and the objectives and impact we aim to achieve across sport for development, competition delivery, coaching, and partnerships over the 2025 - 2027 period.

# Sport for Development

- Increased accessibility to meaningful sporting opportunities for individuals with ID and LD, particularly in underserved areas.
- Reduction of social isolation and loneliness by fostering connection, belonging, and community through regular club and competition engagement.
- Improved personal development and life skills, including confidence, communication, teamwork, and leadership, particularly through opportunities in coaching, officiating, and volunteer roles.
- Enhanced employability by supporting athletes and volunteers to gain transferable skills and experience through structured involvement in the sport.
- Contribute to wider societal change, by promoting a more inclusive society that values and includes people with ID/LD through visible and accessible participation in mainstream table tennis environments and events.

#### **Partnerships**

Strengthen alignment between the Table Tennis England and SOGB systems including closer connections between SOGB clubs and Table Tennis England.

Table Tennis England and SOGB will conduct a pilot with local clubs to test and learn a partnership approach.

Develop closer relationships with

Scotland, exploring cross working
relationships.





## Competition Development

Map out competitions for people with ID and LD within Table Tennis England and SOGB structures to identify gaps and opportunities for collaboration.

Work towards ensuring that SOGB accredited clubs gain access to the Table Tennis England competition pathway where appropriate.

Connect opportunities to high profile SOGB and Table Tennis England national and world championships to increase awareness.

Create opportunities for talented athletes through a clear Paralympic and Virtus pathway.

## Workforce and Coach Development

- Develop an SOGB Umpire Training offer ensuring it aligns to Table Tennis England training.
- Ensure SOGB coaches gain access to Table Tennis England upskilling and development opportunities.
- SOGB supporting Table Tennis
  England affiliated clubs and coaches
  to upskill them in delivering inclusive
  and appropriate sessions for players
- Both organisations agree to adapt the existing SOGB and Mencap's Learning Disability in Sport Workshop to target table tennis coaches and volunteers within Table Tennis England.
- Jointly create a co-branded document outlining the coaching and volunteer development pathways across both organisations.
